

COURSE OFFERINGS

UHM Study Abroad Center *Université de Paris Sorbonne* Semester in Paris, France

Students take a minimum course load of 12 credits. Three of these credits must be from one of the two UHM Resident Director's courses, when available. The remaining credits come from different categories of courses, depending on the student's selected curriculum and placement exam results.

CURRICULUM

- Sorbonne civilization lecture coursestaught in French
